What is it?

A special blend of bromegrasses designed for season long growth, drought tolerance and great winter hardiness.

Why grow it?

Features	Benefits
Rapid regrowth	➤ Season long production for rotational grazing or two cut hay
Improved varieties	➤ 75% Fleet Meadow Bromegrass and 25% Carlton Smooth Bromegrass; varieties suitable to Western Canadian growing conditions
Season long growth	➤ Good spring growth from Carlton, combined with season long growth of Fleet lends itself to multi-cut hay or rotational grazing systems
Great winter hardiness	➤ Developed for Western Canada
Adaptability	➤ Maintains high yields under variable conditions

How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
Seed 12-14 lbs/ac	Thrives in moist, well drained areas; adapted to dryland and irrigation	Graze once 20-30 cm of growth obtained; graze to 8-10 cm. For longevity, 3-4 weeks recovery required.
Seed no deeper than ¾ inch into a firm seed bed	Tolerant to acidic, alkaline, and saline soils	Cut at early heading; earlier cutting enables more regrowth
Good seedling vigour	May become dormant in hot and dry conditions; very drought tolerant	Fertilize according to soil tests; responds well to nitrogen
