

Cattlemans Pasture Mix

What is it?

A widely adaptable pasture mix across Western Canada that provides producers with top growth from early spring and throughout the growing season, it can be used as calving pasture, summer pasture as well as a stockpiled pasture for use in the fall and winter months.

Why grow it?

Features	Benefits
AC Grazeland Alfalfa	➔ This elite pasture mix includes AC Grazeland Br, the world's only bloat reduced alfalfa
Early spring growth	➔ Species in this mixture start growing very early in the spring, providing producers with forage from mid spring and throughout the season
Hardy species	➔ Species in this mixture are tolerant of drought, alkalinity, salinity and perform well in the Dark, Dark Brown, Black and Grey Luvisol soil zones of Western Canada
Excellent regrowth	➔ Most species in this mixture provide good regrowth throughout the growing season, and will provide the high forage quality when rotationally grazed
Very persistent	➔ Long lived mixture adaptable to Western Canada's weather conditions

How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
14-16 lbs/ac	Well adapted to Brown, Dark Brown, Black and Gray Luvisol soils zones, as well as under irrigation	Allow for 8 to 12 inches of top growth in the spring
Seed ¼ to ½ inch deep	Tolerance to salinity, alkalinity and drought	Best results achieved when rotationally grazed
Seed bed should be firm; packing may be required	Long term pasture	Soil test prior to seeding and fertilize accordingly
