

## Dawn Alsike Clover

### What is it?

An improved, high yielding Alsike Clover for low-lying, moist areas.

### Why grow it?

Features	Benefits
Leafy	➤ High palatability
Improved yields	➤ Yields 102% of Aurora
Very good regrowth	➤ Perfect for grazing
Persistent	➤ Maintains high yields for the longevity (3-4 yrs) of the stand
Very winter hardy	➤ Suited to the harsh conditions of Western Canada

### How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
Seed 3-5 lbs/ac	Thrives in gray wooded soils and will withstand flooding for up to 6 weeks	High moisture in the leaves requires extended cure period; permits one cut hay
Seed no deeper than ½ inch into a firm seed bed	High tolerance to acidic and alkaline soils	Bloat potential is similar to alfalfa; not recommended for horse pasture/hay
Vigorous seedlings; capable of surface germination	The clover with the best tolerance to cold or frost	Fertilize according to soil tests; performs well in low fertility and fixes nitrogen well
