How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
Seed at 13 to 15 lbs/ac	Best adapted to Black, Dark Brown Grey Luvisol soil zones and under irrigation	Harvest when alfalfa is at 10% bloom stage
Seed at a depth of ¼ to ½ inch into a firm seedbed	Highly adaptable to variable field conditions	Under favorable weather and fertility conditions, allow for at least 30 days recovery between cuts
Well prepared seed bed is crucial for best establishment results	Can be grazed after the first cut, and provide animals with highly palatable, high quality forage for outstanding gains	Soil test and fertilize accordingly prior to seeding, and monitor annually
