What is it?

A balanced horse pasture mixture offering high quality forage production throughout the growing season, as well as superior traffic tolerance. It can also produce high quality hay.

Why grow it?

Features	Benefits
Highly palatable	➔ This mix provides horse pasture with highly palatable grasses to maintain a thorough grazing pattern throughout the season
Excellent regrowth	➔ All grasses in this mixture are season long growth species that can maintain top growth for grazing when rotationally grazed
Legume source protein	➔ Alfalfa inclusion in this mixture, is at a rate that will provide Horses with the right amount of protein for medium work horses and growing young stock
Persistence	➔ Maintains high yields as stand matures
Excellent winter hardiness	➔ Highly adaptable to varying weather conditions across Western Canada
Dual purpose	➔ Can be used as Pasture or cut as Hay

How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
14-18 lbs/ac	Best suited for Black, Dark Brown, Grey Luvisol soil zones and under irrigation	Allow for 8 to 12 inches of top growth before placing animals in the spring
Seed ¼ to ½ inch deep	Provides pasture early to mid spring, and continues to grow throughout the season	Best results are achieved when rotationally grazed
Seed bed should be firm; packing may be required	Mid to long term pasture production when managed properly	Soil test regularly and Fertilize accordingly for nitrogen
