

Lowlands Pasture Mix

What is it?

A pasture mix designed for those low laying areas in the Prairie Provinces that can remain under water for up to eight weeks.

Why grow it?

Features		Benefits
Excellent spring flooding tolerance	➔	Species used in this mixture can withstand up to 8 weeks of Spring Flooding
Acidity tolerant	➔	Ideal for those peaty soils that tend to be highly acidic
Excellent longevity	➔	With a successful establishment, this mixture can be a permanent cover for those hard to work wet areas
Excellent winter hardiness	➔	Suited to the harsh conditions of Western Canada

How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
Seed 13 - 15 lbs/ac	Adapted to wetter areas; capable of thriving under extreme spring flooding	Field conditions will have the biggest effect on harvesting options
Seed at ¼ to ½ inch depth into a firm seed bed	Tolerant to acidic soils; well suited to peat areas	Can provide season long growth and fast regrowth
Proper seed bed preparation is crucial for best establishment results	Withstands wet and cool weather conditions, and some drought	Fertilize according to soil test prior to seeding, and monitor levels regularly once established

Note: Not recommended for hay/pasture horse mix.
