

## PasturePro Mix

### What is it?

Highly productive pasture mix suitable for all sorts of livestock, for those producers looking to maximize their livestock production in the Black, Grey Luvisol, Dark Brown soil zones, as well as under irrigation.

### Why grow it?

| Excellent winter hardiness | ➔ Suited to the harsh conditions of Western Canada  |

### How to grow it...

| Seeding Information                              | Adaptations   | Management  |

| 13-15 lbs/ac                                     | Best adapted to Black, Grey Luvisol, Dark Brown soil zones and under irrigation | Allow for 8 to 10 inches of top growth before placing any animals in the spring                         |
| Seed ¼ to ½ inch deep                            | Will produce best on well drained highly productive soils                       | Hay the first year's crop, so that plants get a chance to establish                                     |
| Seed bed should be firm; packing may be required | Medium rotation mixture   | To maintain the orchardgrass in the stand, do not graze while plants are dormant in the fall and winter |
