

RangePro Pasture Mix

What is it?

An all grass, highly productive, highly adaptable pasture mixture that will provide producers with pasture from early to mid spring and throughout the growing season.

Why grow it?

Features	Benefits
Earliest pasture mix	➔ This pasture mixture can be used for Calving as it has some of the earliest grasses in Western Canada
Full season growth	➔ RangePro will produce from early spring and never stop until there is a killing frost in late summer or early fall
Excellent adaptability	➔ Adapted to all soil zone areas in the Prairie Provinces
Excellent winter hardiness	➔ Suited to the harsh conditions of Western Canada
Excellent palatability	➔ This pasture mixture consists of some of the most palatable grasses available in Western Canada

How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
Seed 14 to 16 lbs/ac	Best adapted to the Black, Grey Luvisol, Dark Brown and Brown soil zones of the Prairies, as well as under irrigation	Allow for one full year of growth before placing any animals in this pasture
Seed at ¼ to ¾ inch depth into a firm seed bed	Variable soil and field conditions are moderately tolerated with this mixture	For the best quality hay, keep enough grazing pressure so that Crested Wheatgrass does not reach heading stage
Proper seed bed preparation is crucial for best establishment results	Tolerant to early spring grazing pressure	Fertilize according to soil test prior to seeding, and monitor levels regularly once established
