

SaltPro Forage Mix

What is it?

A forage seed mixture designed for those areas with salinity problems, and provide producers with high quality forage that will produce close to the fields potential, and alleviate some of those salinity problems.

Why grow it?

Features	Benefits
Deep rooted species	➡ Species in this mixture have the capacity to penetrate deep into the soil, to help alleviate those lower laying areas with high Salt content, as well as use up most of the moisture from deep in the soil throughout the field to prevent salt from surfacing in those low laying areas
Very persistent	➡ This forage mixture is designed to produce as a long term pasture that can be grazed at any time of the year
Year long usage	➡ SaltPro can be used as Calving Pasture, Summer Pasture, first growth can be hayed, and regrowth left as stockpiled pasture to provide forage to livestock in the fall and winter months
Good winter hardiness	➡ Good adaptability to most Western Canadian growing conditions

How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
15 - 18 lbs/ac	Designed for those fields in the Dark Brown and Brown soil zones experiencing salinity problems, as well as, under irrigation	Allow for one full season for forage to establish, it can be harvested as hay in the establishing year. It is crucial to control weeds before seeding
Seed ¼ to ½ inch deep	Tolerance to saline and alkaline soils, some species are also adapted to imperfectly drained soils	Can be used as calving pasture, and let rest during the summer to be used as stockpiled pasture in Fall and Winter
Seed bed should be firm; packing may be required	Excellent winter hardiness	Fertilize according to soil tests
