

## Stockmans Mixture

### What is it?

A highly productive pasture mixture with non-bloat legumes for those producers who still require legumes, but want peace of mind when it comes to bloat risk.

### Why grow it?

Features		Benefits
Highly adaptable	➔	Widely adapted to the soil and weather conditions across the Prairie Provinces
High yielding	➔	This pasture mixture will start growing early in the spring, and continue throughout the whole growing season
Persistent	➔	Maintains high yields as the stand matures
Versatility	➔	This pasture mixture is ideal for any type of livestock requiring forage in their diets
Excellent winter hardiness	➔	Adaptable to weather conditions in Western Canada

### How to grow it...

Seeding Information	Adaptations	Management
Seed 14 to 16 lbs/ac	Adapted to the Brown, Dark Brown, Black and Grey Luvisol soil zones and under irrigation	Allow for 10 to 12 inches of top growth before placing livestock in the pasture
Seed at ¼ to ½ inch depth into a firm seed bed	Variable soil and field conditions are tolerated by this mixture	Avoid grazing while plants are dormant, to ensure maximum longevity of the Orchardgrass
Proper seed bed preparation is crucial for best establishment results	Tolerant of some acidity, flooding, alkalinity, salinity and drought	Fertilize according to soil test prior to seeding, and monitor levels regularly once established
