- Hybrid between smooth brome grass and meadow brome grass
- Looks more like smooth brome grass but has excellent yield and has better regrowth than meadow brome grass.
- Very productive and palatable
- Excellent persistence and winter hardiness
- Improved forage quality (great companion to alfalfa)
- Can be pastured
- Not as invasive as smooth brome grass
- Excellent regrowth
- Lower tolerance to flooding
- Moderately tolerant to acidic soils

AC® Success Hybrid Brome grass

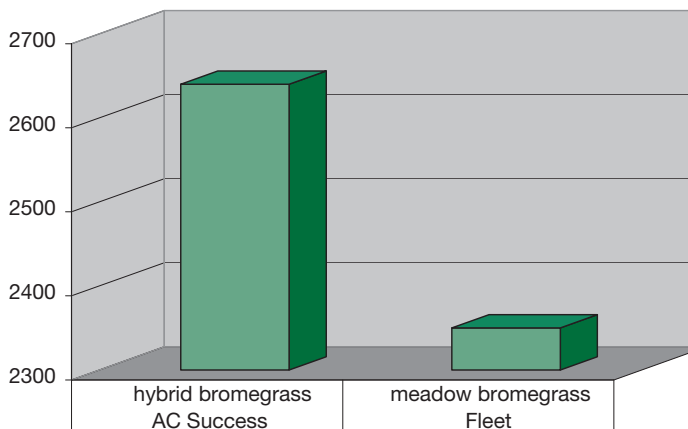
AC® Success is a backcross of a smooth brome grass breeding population with a hybrid brome grass population. The result is a hybrid brome grass that is more smooth brome grass-like in appearance than other hybrid brome grasses (like AC Knowles hybrid brome). Hybrid brome grass does not require variety registration in Canada. Success was granted a “Certificate for Eligibility of Certification” which allows us to produce Certified seed of the variety.

This variety was developed by selecting from Paddock and Fleet meadow brome grasses, and smooth brome grass plants mainly from Signal background. Success was selected for uniformity of plant type, seed production, regrowth, reduced creeping tendency, vigour and good late fall greenness and growth.

AC® Success has better regrowth than Carlton (smooth) or Paddock (meadow) or AC Knowles (hybrid) brome grasses.

AC® Success has better overall forage quality (CP, ADF, NDF) than either Carlton or Fleet.
