<h1>Checkmate</h1> <p>Orchardgrass</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Late maturity range (similar to Pennlate)</li> <li>▪ Dark-green color (darker than Pennlate and Haymate)</li> <li>▪ Very high stress tolerance</li> <li>▪ Very leafy</li> <li>▪ Consistently high forage yields</li> </ul>
<h1>Orca</h1> <p>Orchardgrass</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Medium early heading, several days later than Potomac</li> <li>▪ Mixes well with other species</li> <li>▪ Very long lived perennial, very winter hardy</li> <li>▪ Very good drought tolerance</li> <li>▪ Suitable for hay or pasture</li> <li>▪ Excellent performance data</li> </ul>
<h1>Pizza</h1> <p>Orchardgrass</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Late maturity range (similar to Pennlate)</li> <li>▪ European type with delicate leaves</li> <li>▪ High voluntary animal intake</li> <li>▪ High nutrition values translating into high animal performance</li> <li>▪ Excellent with alfalfa</li> </ul>
<h1>Stampede</h1> <p>Orchardgrass</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Medium maturity range</li> <li>▪ Proven performer over time / locations</li> <li>▪ High forage yields</li> <li>▪ Excellent for mono-stands or in mixtures of grasses and legumes</li> <li>▪ Strong performance under multiple harvests</li> <li>▪ Winter hardy</li> </ul>
